RE: Liability Coverage for Out of Country Activities

Effective immediately all out of country activities (summer camps, training, etc.) requires your membership to specifically seek a sanction from you before the CSA will approve the camp/activity.

The sanction request form is attached and will be included in the revised CSA Club Risk Management Manual.

The CSA will vet each request as well and must specifically approve these requests before they will be approved for liability coverage.

I expect there should not be too much difficulty with USA based activities.
