General Information:

Competition shall be governed by F.I.S. Freestyle general Rules & Regulations and policies and procedures of the Canadian Freestyle Ski Association (CFSA).

This competition is sanctioned by CFSA and organized by Freestyle Skiing Ontario (FSO) with support of the Southern Ontario Region Freestyle Club (SOR) and the Beaver Valley Ski Club (BVSC). All athletes must be registered members of CFSA for 2011 (as of June 1, 2011 with a Canadian Competitor Licence (or higher).





The competition is composed of two official events – Single Moguls and Dual Moguls. The competition will proceed as follows and in accordance with the Official Program.

A \$20.00 cash bib deposit will be collected at registration. All competitors must wear their bibs during official training, competition and on-hill award ceremonies. Bibs will be available at the registration desk. The bib deposit will be returned when athletes return their bibs at the end of the competition.

Refund Policy

In the event of a cancellation of an event due to weather conditions, athletes scheduled to participate in that event shall be refunded \$20.00, if more than one event is cancelled the maximum amount an athlete will receive is \$40.00.
