**3. Format**

**Halfpipe & Slopestyle:**

Qualifications will be scheduled in heats with the Best of Two runs counting. Top scores in each heat will advance to finals along with limited wild card spots taken from the next highest scores in the qualifications. Draw for the heats will be set in the Thursday at the Team Captains Meeting. Ties in qualifications, will be decided by the highest Other Run score. From qualifications, 6 ladies and 12 men will advance to ski in a one run final Friday, March 9, 2012

**Junior Nationals for Halfpipe:** Age categories will be included on the start list, and everyone competes together in heats. Winners will be determined from the qualifying results (best of two runs) in the junior M2/F2, juvenile M3/F3 and youth M4/F4 categories as the Junior National Champions in Halfpipe for males and females.

\*Athletes can win both the Junior Nationals and the open event.
